Primary job responsibilities:

- Set up plastic injection molding machines to run concurrent production.
- Has responsibility for following molding operating procedures. Visually inspects molding machine and mold before placing mold in the machine.
- Use hoist, if necessary, to place mold in machine.
- Be able to set up assignments and complete work orders.
- Following set up procedure and evaluation of work order data, to proceed to set up the running operation of the injection molding machine.
- Be able to enter data in computer.
- Before running determine that all auxiliary equipment is available and production is ready. Checking dryers, chillers, mold heaters, chutes, special nozzles, and cleans area.
- Monitor production to run as close as possible to the standard cycle time.
- Operate machinery within the guidelines of all safety standards.
- Maintain quality of product.
- Visual inspection by use of calipers, comparators and gauge pins.
- Removing of molds by following department procedures.
- Responsible for shut down and lock-out procedures.

Requirements:

- Be able to rotate shifts for the purpose of covering sick, vacations and training purposes from days to nights and vice versa.
